1	<p>“Offerer Affirmation of Understanding of, and Compliance with, Procurement Lobbying Guidelines”:</p> <p>I did not submit this by Dec. 12<sup>th</sup>; can I submit with my Bid?</p>	<p>The “Offerer Affirmation of Understanding of, and Compliance with, Procurement Lobbying Guidelines” can be submitted late; however the Form should be submitted as soon as possible.</p>
2	<p>Your IFB request for a Computer to Plate Image and Proofing System:</p> <p>“The CTP device must be semi-automatic with an online plate processor and plate stacker...”</p> <p>It does not mention a Plate processor and a stacker. Are they part of the Bid?</p>	<p>As the specification indicates, the online processor and plate stacker are part of the Bid.</p>
3	<p>“Must support PDF 1.3, postscript 3, TIFF 6.0, JPEG, CALS/G4, HP RTL, and HP1GL/2, and be capable of printing media up to a maximum width of 40” to 46” and the ability to support a minimum of 6 ink colors.”</p> <p>I do not understand this request; there is no RIP that will accept an HPRTL and HPIGL/2.</p>	<p>The Department is aware of at least one (1) device that can support HP RTL and HP1GL/2.; however, the Department is waiving this requirement. Please see the Department’s website for this revision.</p>
4	<p>An Epson 9800 is only capable of printing up to 44” and not 46”.</p>	<p>Width between 40” to 46” is acceptable.</p>
