(X) Does not impose tax on net income.

(1) Alternative minimum tax (AMT) imposed at a rate of 5.8%.

(2) Plus \$2.60 per \$1,000 of tangible property or net worth allocated to Massachusetts. Rates include 14% surtax.

(3) AMT rate on capital gains is 4.5%. AMT on tax preference items is 18% of the applicable Federal AMT.

(4) Corporations must pay the greater of the tax based on net income, an alternative minimum tax assessment on gross receipts or profits, or a minimum tax. A surtax of 4% is also imposed.

(5) AMT imposed equal to 5.4% of alternative minimum taxable income.

(6) A 1.5% rate applies to S corporations. Banks and financial corporations, including financial S corps, add an additional 2% rate to their respective base rates.

(7) Rate is 8.5% of taxable business profits if gross income over \$50,000. For gross income over \$150,000 or base over \$75,000, business enterprise tax also applies at a rate of 0.75% of business enterprise value base.

(8) Rate is 40% of greater of 5.1% on the first \$50,000 of taxable income plus 8.5% on taxable income in excess of \$50,000, 4 mills times taxable net worth up to \$150,000 maximum, or a fixed minimum tax.

(9) Franchise tax is the greater of the applicable net income tax rate, 3.1 mills per dollar of capital holding, or the minimum tax of \$250. Corporations filing combined returns subject to an additional tax up to \$250,000.

(10) Rates includes a 3.35% surtax is imposed on taxable income in excess of \$50,000.

(11) Tax equals higher of 7.1% of net income, AMT at the rate of 1.5%, 0.15% of allocated capital, or a fixed minimum tax. Additional 9/10 mill per dollar of allocated subsidiary capital is also imposed.

(12) Taxpayers making a water's edge election are taxed at 7%.

(13) Corporations making water's edge election must pay an additional 3.5% tax.

(14) Taxpayers who pay federal AMT are liable for the greater of the income tax or the 3.3% Florida AMT.

(15) Additional 2.5%, 1.5% for S corporations, personal property replacement tax imposed.

(16) 0.5% for retailers or wholesalers. Imposed on entities with with over \$300,000 in gross revenues on lesser of 70% of total revenues or 100% of gross receipts after certain deductions and subject to variable discounts ranging from 80% to 20% depending on taxpayer's amount of revenue.

(17) Plus 0.8% of modified gross receipts of \$350,000 or more. A surcharge of 21.99% applies.

(18) Business and Occupation (B&O) Tax with rates dependent on business type.

(19) Headquarters management corporations pay a minimum tax equal to greater of \$5,000 or tax at 8.7% rate.

(20) Financial corporations are subject to a rate of 7.92% of net income.

(21) At top rate tier, tax equals product of rate and income minus \$7,500.

(22) Plus \$56,000.
